

REQUIREMENTS OF REACH / CLP

Valid as of 1/1/2016

Based on Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council – the REACH Regulation, we require:

- a safety data sheet (SDS) in the Czech language in accordance with Article 31 of REACH as amended or a communication in accordance with Article 32(1) of REACH as amended for substances and mixtures for which a SDS does not need to be provided,
- relevant exposure scenarios in the annex to the SDS in the Czech language pursuant to Article 31(7)(1) of the REACH Regulation, as amended, or information from exposure scenarios included in the SDS pursuant to Article 31(7)(2) and (7)(3) of the REACH Regulation, as amended (information from exposure scenarios should be marked),
- REACH registration number in subsection 1.1 SDS, if available,
- the classification of substances and mixtures listed in Sections 2 and 3 of the SDS in accordance with Annex II of REACH as amended,
- the classification of substances and/or mixtures in Sections 2 and 3 of the SDS made in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008. If classifications are made in accordance with Directive 67/548/EEC or Directive 1999/45/EC, send a justification for the classifications made in accordance with the above-mentioned directives,
- justification for not translating any of the above information.

In the event of a revision of the above documents within the next 12 months after the delivery of the goods, we request the provision of these updated documents in accordance with Article 31(9) of the REACH Regulation as amended.

Based on Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council – the CLP Regulation, we require:

- labelling of packaging in the Czech language in accordance with Article 17(2) of the CLP Regulation as amended,
- labelling of packaging containing hazardous substances/mixtures in accordance with Title III of the CLP Regulation, as amended.

On the basis of Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council - REACH Regulation, we require the following information from you as a supplier of the article(s):

- whether any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC), i.e. a substance included on the Candidate List (for possible inclusion in REACH Annex XIV - List of substances subject to authorisation) is present in the article you are supplying in a concentration greater than 0.7% by weight. If so, what substance is it and in what concentration is it present in the article.

If any of the above substances are present, please also tell us what measures need to be taken to make the item safe to use, or that no such measures need to be taken.



In this context, please note that the concentration threshold of 0.1% by weight for substances on the list of substances (for possible inclusion in Annex XIV of REACH) applies to each article supplied. This threshold applies to each item in each case consisting of multiple article that have been joined or assembled.
